ORDER

Western Fleming County Water District (“Western Fleming”) has applied to the Commission for approval to adjust its rates and to increase certain non-recurring charges. Western Fleming was notified that its filing was deficient and required compliance with certain requirements of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001 in order that the application could be deemed administratively complete. Western Fleming has submitted its response to that notification and has requested permission to deviate from the filing requirement of Section 10(7)(d) of the above regulation.

Section 10(7)(d) requires submission of the operating budget for each month of the period encompassing the pro forma adjustments. In support of its request for permission to deviate from this requirement, Western Fleming states that it does not produce monthly reports on a routine basis and that additional expense would be incurred to produce them at this time.

Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, provides the Commission with the authority to permit deviations from its regulations for good cause shown. Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission

finds that the information contained in Western Fleming's application is sufficient for our review of the application and that requiring the submission of the monthly reports in this instance would result in increased rate case expense without any corresponding benefit to the ratepayers, the Commission or the public.

The Commission further finds that Western Fleming's September 6, 2007 filing and its request for deviation satisfy the minimum filing requirements and its application should be deemed administratively complete as of September 6, 2007.

Finding that good cause exists, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Western Fleming's request for permission to deviate from the filing requirements of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(7)(d), is granted.
2. Western Fleming's application is accepted for filing as of September 6, 2007.
