O R D E R

The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention (“AG”), has filed a motion to intervene in this case. The AG maintains that KRS 367.150(8) authorizes him the right and obligation to appear before the Commission to represent consumers’ interests. The AG requests full intervenor status pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(8).

The AG also moved the Commission for permission to participate fully in this proceeding, including serving data requests on the applicant as well as filing comments and recommendations to the Commission concerning the application. The AG asserts that it would be necessary for him to issue data requests to the applicant in order to fully understand the applicant’s extensive and complex data supplied in conjunction with its application.

The Commission finds that intervention is fully authorized by statute.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the AG’s motion to intervene is granted and the AG is accorded full intervenor status entitling him to participate in discovery and the filing of comments.
