O R D E R

Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government ("LFUCG") having moved to amend the existing procedural schedule in this matter to permit the parties an additional 30 days in which to develop additional evidence regarding alternative means of expanding Kentucky-American Water Company's water supply and the Commission finding that the parties to this proceeding should be afforded a definite period of time in which to respond to this motion, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Any party wishing to respond to LFUCG's motion shall file its response with the Commission no later than January 15, 2008.
2. Pending a decision upon LFUCG's motion, the procedural schedule in this matter is stayed.¹
