

COMMISSION STAFF'S NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME

On August 14, 2008, Madison County Utilities District ("Madison District") filed a request for an extension of time in which to answer Commission Staff's data request dated July 29, 2008. The utility seeks a one-week extension until August 22, 2008 to complete and file the requested information. No procedural schedule has been entered by the Commission. Commission Staff hereby grants Madison District's request; responses to Commission Staff's data request are due on August 22, 2008.

Commission Staff notes that Madison District's request was not signed by an attorney. 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(3), requires that "[e]very pleading of a party represented by an attorney shall be signed by at least one (1) attorney of record in his individual name and shall state his address." Both the application and request for extension of time reference Charles Hardin as the utility's attorney. Madison District is warned that future pleadings must be signed by an attorney of record. Failure to comply with this administrative regulation will result in rejection of the filing.
