ORDER

On February 6, 2014, U.S. 60 Water District of Shelby and Franklin Counties (“US 60 WD”) filed an application to establish certain non-recurring charges relating to the provision of water service and to increase its existing tap-on fees for certain meter sizes. US 60 WD’s application included tariff sheets with a proposed effective date of April 1, 2014.

Having reviewed the proposed tariffs, we find that further proceedings are necessary to determine their reasonableness, that these proceedings cannot be completed prior to the effective date of the proposed tariffs, and that the proposed tariffs should be suspended pursuant to KRS 278.190(2).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. This proceeding is established to investigate the reasonableness of US 60 WD’s proposed tariffs.
2. US 60 WD’s proposed tariffs are suspended for five months from April 1, 2014, up to and including August 31, 2014.
