
ORDER

On July 1, 2024, Cellco Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless and TowerCom (together, Joint Applicants) filed a notice of intent to use electronic filing, stating it would file an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a wireless communications facility no later than September 30, 2024. On October 9, 2024, the Joint Applicants filed a request to withdraw the notice of intent to use electronic filing. Based on the request to withdraw the notice and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the Joint Applicants established good cause to withdraw their application, and therefore, this proceeding should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is dismissed and removed from the Commission's Docket.
