SITING BOARD STAFF'S REQUEST FOR INFORMATION  
TO SEBREE SOLAR II, LLC

Sebree Solar II, LLC (Sebree Solar II), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on May 16, 2025. The Siting Board directs Sebree Solar II to the Kentucky Public Service Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085<sup>1</sup> regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the

person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Sebree Solar II shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Sebree Solar II obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Sebree Solar II fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Sebree Solar II shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied or scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Sebree Solar II shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Provide a status update for the project.
2. Refer to the statement in the motion regarding anticipated tax equity, construction, and back leverage financing(s).
  - a. Provide a timeline for each of the financings including an estimated month and year.

b. Provide a description of each transaction including whether the project or any portion thereof would be used as leverage for any of the three financing requests.

c. Provide the name of the specific party that will be responsible for ensuring the mitigation measures are satisfied for each type of financing.

d. Explain whether the project could move forward with any one of the financings or does the situation require all three types of financing. Include in the explanation what circumstances changed since the conditional construction certificate.

3. Explain whether Sebree Solar II is current on any occupational taxes owed to Henderson County.

4. Provide any draft agreements for structure changes related to this motion for approval of change in ownership.
