<u>ORDER</u>

On May 27, 2025, East Pendleton Water District (East Pendleton District) applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure set forth in KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

LEGAL STANDARD

In accordance with KRS 278.015, when a wholesale supplier selling water to a water district increases its rates, the water district has the authority to increase its rate commensurate with the wholesale supplier. The water district must file, within the statutory and regulatory deadlines, a copy of the notice from the wholesale supplier showing the increase in the wholesale rate, and a statement of the volume of purchased water used to calculate the rate adjustment. The Commission shall approve the filing by order after the above documents are filed.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

East Pendleton District purchases water from the city of Falmouth (Falmouth) and Bracken County Water District (Bracken District). Falmouth notified East Pendleton District that its wholesale rate would increase by \$0.67 from \$1.98 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.65 per 1,000 gallons, effective May 23, 2025.¹ East Pendleton District proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective June 13, 2025, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Falmouth. Bracken District proposed no rate changes.

Unaccounted-for Water Loss

Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 6(3), states that for ratemaking purposes a utility's unaccounted-for water loss shall not exceed 15 percent of the total water produced and purchased, excluding water consumed by a utility in its own operations. In its 2022 Annual Report filed with the Commission, East Pendleton District reported a water loss of 5.6097 percent.² In its 2023 Annual Report filed with the Commission, East Pendleton District reported a water loss of 7.4154 percent.³ In its 2024 Annual Report⁴ filed with the Commission, East Pendleton District reported a water loss of 8.7324 percent.⁵ East Pendleton District's three-year water loss average is 7.2525 percent.⁶

Financial Condition and Rates

Based on a review of Commission records, East Pendleton District last sought an alternative rate adjustment in Case No. 2013-00103.⁷ Case No. 2013-00103 resulted in an authorized increased to East Pendleton District's rates of \$210,459 or 24.53 percent.⁸ East Pendleton has not requested another rate adjustment since the last alternative rate filing adjustment mentioned above.

In Case No. 2019-00041, the Commission discussed the problems that can occur when utilities intentionally avoid a review of their financial records by relying solely on financing cases to increase rates.⁹ A key recommendation from that proceeding was that water districts should monitor the sufficiency of their base rates closely and, in general, apply for base rate adjustments on a more frequent basis.¹⁰

Based upon a review of the annual and audit reports filed with the Commission, East Pendleton District's rate-based income, or adjusted net income minus principal payments, was positive from 2020 through 2024. Cash-based income, or rate-based income plus depreciation, was positive from 2020 through 2024. A chart summarizing cash basis and rate-based income is presented below.

Given this information, the Commission recommends East Pendleton District monitor its operating performance annually and consider filing future rate cases no less than every three to five years, depending on operating performance, to ensure that its revenue is sufficient to support adequate and reliable service.

Purchased Water Adjustment Factor

In its application, East Pendleton District proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.76 per 1,000 gallons. During the 12 months ended 2025, East Pendleton District purchased 107,070,688 gallons of water from Falmouth and 1,020,390 gallons of

water from Bracken District and sold 95,031,972 gallons of water to its customers. The increase in the cost of purchased water from Falmouth is \$71,737.36, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.76 per 1,000 gallons. No rate changes occurred from Bracken District.

The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.76 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A and the rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered by East Pendleton District on and after June 13, 2025, because the rates are supported by evidence of the increase in rates from East Pendleton District's wholesale water supplier and the volume of purchased water used to calculate the rates in accordance with KRS 278.015.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.76 per 1,000 gallons is approved.

2. The rates proposed by East Pendleton District are approved.

3. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by East Pendleton District on and after June 13, 2025.

4. Within 20 days of the date of service of this Order, East Pendleton District shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.

5. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
