ORDER

On August 29, 2025, Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power) filed an application for a general adjustment of rates based on a historical test period and included other related accounting requests and tariff changes.¹

The Commission, on its own motion, provides notice to all parties that three in-person public comment meetings will be held on the below dates and locations for the purpose of receiving public comment on this proceeding. The public comment meetings should be recorded and filed into the case record.

The Commission finds that Kentucky Power should ensure that a representative(s) is present at each of the public meetings. The remaining parties are encouraged to provide representative(s) at each of the public meetings. In addition, Kentucky Power should publish notice of the public comment meetings in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001,

Section 9(2). Within 20 days after publication, Kentucky Power shall file proof of publication in the file.

In addition to the opportunity to provide public comments at the meetings scheduled in this Order, written public comments may be tendered to the Commission at any time during the consideration of this case. Written public comments should include name, address, and reference Case No. 2025-00257. Written public comments may be mailed to the PSC at P.O. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A local public comment meeting for the purpose of hearing public comments shall be held on November 20, 2025, 5 p.m. Eastern Standard Time, at the Pike County Public Library District: 126 Lee Avenue, Rooms 306-307, Pikeville, Kentucky 41501.
2. A local public comment meeting for the purpose of hearing public comments shall be held on December 18, 2025, 5 p.m. Eastern Standard Time, at the Perry County Courthouse, 481 Main Street, 2nd Floor, Hazard, Kentucky 41701.
3. A local public comment meeting for the purpose of hearing public comments shall be held on January 8, 2026, at 5 p.m. Eastern Standard Time, at the Ashland Transportation Center, 99 15th Street, Ashland, Kentucky 41101.
4. No evidence shall be taken at the local public comment meetings.
5. Recordings of the in-person public comment meetings will be filed into the record of this case.

6. Kentucky Power shall provide written notice of the time and place of the local public comment meetings pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2).

7. Within 20 days after publication, Kentucky Power shall file proof of publication in the file.

8. Kentucky Power shall ensure that a representative(s) is present at each of the public comment meetings.
