ORDER

On December 11, 2025, Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. (Duke Kentucky) filed a motion for leave to file instanter and its reply comments. Duke Kentucky noted that on September 22, 2025, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention, filed a public comment questioning the benefit of Duke Kentucky's proposed Energy Efficiency in Education Program as part of its demand-side management (DSM) programs. Duke Kentucky sought to file a response comment, which it included in its motion.<sup>1</sup>

Having reviewed the motion and being advised, the Commission finds that the motion should be granted and Duke Kentucky permitted to file its comment.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Duke Kentucky's December 11, 2025 motion is granted and Duke Kentucky's comment is accepted as filed and made part of the record in this matter.


