ORDER

This matter arises from McKinney Water District's (McKinney District) motion requesting additional time, until March 13, 2026, to respond to Commission Staff's Fourth Request for Information.<sup>1</sup> There are no other parties to this proceeding. For the reasons outlined below, the Commission finds that the motion should be granted.

On September 1, 2023, this case was initiated by Commission Order for the purpose of monitoring McKinney District's unaccounted-for water loss reduction plan surcharge.<sup>2</sup> McKinney District was required to file a qualified infrastructure improvement plan (QIIP) within 120 days of service of the Order, and to seek Commission approval before using any water loss surcharge funds.<sup>3</sup>

McKinney District filed its QIIP on December 26, 2023,<sup>4</sup> and requested to use surcharge funds on March 12, 2025.<sup>5</sup> Commission Staff held two informal conferences<sup>6</sup> and issued one request for information related to the McKinney District's request.<sup>7</sup> On March 2, 2026, McKinney District filed a motion requesting additional time to respond to Commission Staff's Request for Information.<sup>8</sup> In support of its motion, McKinney District stated it has been short staffed due to sicknesses and vacation leave.<sup>9</sup> Further, McKinney District provided that the additional time would allow it to gather the documents needed to properly respond to the requests.<sup>10</sup>

On March 4, 2026, one day late, McKinney District filed its responses to Staff's Fourth Request.<sup>11</sup> The Commission finds that McKinney District's Motion for Additional Time should be granted, and notes that McKinney District's March 4, 2026, responses satisfy the obligation to respond.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. McKinney District's Motion for Additional Time is granted.
2. McKinney District's responses filed March 4, 2026, satisfy its obligation to respond to Commission Staff's Fourth Request for Information.
