ORDER

On July 22, 2026, Kenergy Corporation (Kenergy) filed a motion for a deviation from 807 KAR 5:041, Section 7, pursuant to an Order previously issued in Case No. 2025-00131.¹

In support of this request, Kenergy stated its AMI meters are capable of monitoring systemwide voltage and producing on demand readings, as well as producing exception reports other than voltage, such as communication errors.² In addition, Kenergy stated their AMI Meters record hourly integrated voltage readings transmitted by the meter, which are collected in a database and imported to a Microsoft Excel file for production of a graph.³ Kenergy affirmed these hourly voltage readings are kept in perpetuity and are available for inspection by utility members and Commission Staff.⁴

Furthermore, Kenergy claimed that field personnel have other equipment capable of monitoring and recording voltage, such as multimeters and recording voltmeters

capable of being installed on a meter base at a set location if the accuracy of AMI equipment needs to be verified.⁵

LEGAL STANDARD

The Commission has exclusive jurisdiction over the regulation of rates and service of utilities in Kentucky.⁶ Pursuant to KRS 278.042, the Commission shall prescribe the service adequacy and safety standards for electric utilities, as stated in the Commission's administrative regulations, orders, and in the most recent edition of the National Electrical Safety Code (NESC).⁷ In keeping with KRS Chapter 13A, the Commission may adopt reasonable regulations and investigate the methods and practices of utilities to require them to conform to the laws of this state, and to all reasonable rules, regulations and orders of the commission not contrary to law.⁸ Accordingly, the Commission adopted 807 KAR 5:041, Section 7, of which sets forth rules regarding voltage survey standards. Additionally, in special cases for good cause shown, the Commission may permit deviations from these rules.⁹

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission grants Kenergy's motion. The Commission finds that the technology scheduled to be installed will allow for Kenergy to monitor its voltage in the manner contemplated by the regulation. The Division of Inspections shall make the final

determination as to compliance with the regulation. This deviation should expire when the next amendment to 807 KAR 5:041, Section 7, becomes effective.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Kenergy's motion for deviation from voltage survey requirements in 807 KAR 5:041, Section 7, is granted.

2. The Division of Inspections shall make the final determination as to compliance with the regulation.

3. This deviation shall expire when the next amendment to 807 KAR 5:041, Section 7, is effective.

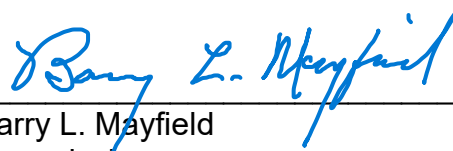
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
