ORDER

On August 18, 2026, the Commission issued a final Order<sup>1</sup> in this matter regarding the two-year review of Kentucky Utilities Company's (KU) Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) and setting forth the approved base fuel cost. However, ordering paragraph 4 of the August 18, 2026 Order contained a scrivener's error regarding the new and old base fuel costs.<sup>2</sup> In ordering paragraph 4, the new base fuel costs were inadvertently switched with the old base fuel costs.

Finding that the August 18, 2026 Order should be amended, the Commission  
HEREBY ORDERS, *nunc pro tunc*, that:

1. The following is stricken in its entirety from ordering paragraph 4, page 7 of the final Order:

KU shall increase its base energy rates by \$0.00162 per kWh for service rendered on and after September 1, 2026, to reflect the increase of \$0.00162 per kWh to KU's base fuel costs, which is the differential between the prior base fuel cost of \$0.03067 per kWh and the new base fuel cost of \$0.02905 per kWh.

And replaced with the following language:

KU shall increase its base energy rates by \$0.00162 per kWh for service rendered on and after September 1, 2026, to reflect the increase of \$0.00162 per kWh to KU's base fuel costs, which is the differential between the prior base fuel cost of \$0.02905 per kWh and the new base fuel cost of \$0.03067 per kWh.

2. All other provisions of the Commission's August 18, 2026 Order that are not in conflict with the terms of this Order shall remain in effect.

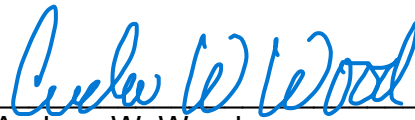
