COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR INFORMATION  
TO LAUREL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 2

Laurel County Water District No. 2 (Laurel District No. 2), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on March 11, 2026. The Commission directs Laurel District No. 2 to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085<sup>1</sup> regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Laurel District No. 2 shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Laurel District No. 2 obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Laurel District No. 2 fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Laurel District No. 2 shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Laurel District No. 2 shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

The Fiscal Court minutes identify the appointments of Teresa Brewer and Steven Cornn. Confirm the Fiscal Court minutes provided are for a re-appointment, and not the initial appointment, for Steven Cornn. If it is a re-appointment, provide the

appointment date and documentation from the Fiscal Court that authorized his initial appointment.

2. Refer to Laurel County District No. 2's response to Staff's Second Request for Information (Staff's Second Request), Item 6. Laurel District No 2 provided the initial registration for Steven Cornn's 12 hours of new commissioner training at Pine Mountain State Resort Park on July 20 - 21, 2022 but did not provide the certificate of completion for the training. Provide the certificate of completion for Steven Cornn's new commissioner training.

3. Refer to Staff's First Request, Item 12d. Provide a copy of any invoices Laurel District No. 2 has received from Kentucky Rural Water Association (KRWA).

4. Refer to the Application, Attachment\_12\_LCWD\_Rate\_Study\_25-353.xlsx, Medical Tab, row 24.

a. Confirm that employee number 19 was hired on November 25, 2025.

b. If confirmed, identify the name of the position of employee number 19 and their full-time or part-time status.

c. Confirm that employee number 19 is currently receiving insurance, if not provide the date they will begin to receive insurance.

5. Refer to Laurel District No. 2's response to Commission Staff's First request, Item 8c. Provide an updated copy of the most recent invoice for each employee benefit that includes employee number 19.
