ORDER

On January 21, 2026, Atmos Energy Corporation (Atmos) filed a motion, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878, requesting that the Commission grant confidential treatment for an indefinite period for certain documents provided with its responses to Commission Staff's First Request for Information that contain supplier pricing information, Asset Management Agreement (AMA) pricing support, and invoices reflecting supplier pricing.

In support of its motion, Atmos argued that disclosure of supplier pricing information would result in competitive harm to Atmos Energy in negotiating contracts with suppliers in the future and allow competitors to gain information regarding Atmos Energy's gas purchases, overall costs, and business strategies.

Having considered the motion and the material at issue, the Commission finds that supplier pricing information is generally recognized as confidential or proprietary. The material therefore meets the criteria for confidential treatment and should be exempted from public disclosure pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878(1)(c).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Atmos's January 21, 2026 motion for confidential treatment is granted.

2. The designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order shall not be placed in the public record or made available for public inspection for an indefinite period or until further order of this Commission.

3. Use of the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order in any Commission proceeding shall comply with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(9).

4. If the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order becomes publicly available or no longer qualifies for confidential treatment, Atmos shall inform the Commission and file with the Commission an unredacted copy of the designated material.

5. If a nonparty to this proceeding requests to inspect the material granted confidential treatment by this Order and the period during which the material has been granted confidential treatment has not expired, Atmos shall have 20 days from receipt of written notice of the request to demonstrate that the material still falls within the exclusions from disclosure requirements established in KRS 61.878. If Atmos is unable to make such demonstration, the requested material shall be made available for inspection. Otherwise, the Commission shall deny the request for inspection.

6. The Commission shall not make the requested material available for inspection for 30 days from the date of service of an Order finding that the material no longer qualifies for confidential treatment in order to allow Atmos to seek a remedy afforded by law.

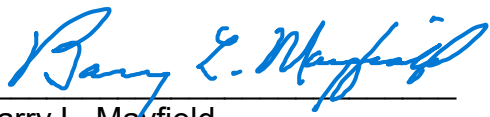

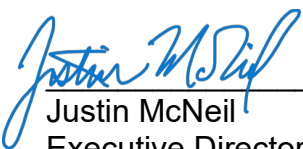
