ORDER

On February 5, 2026, Taylor County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (Taylor RECC) filed a motion, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878, requesting that the Commission grant confidential treatment for the agreed upon purchase price contained in the purchase and sale agreement submitted as an exhibit to its application until the purchase and sale agreement is approved and the purchase and sale is completed.

In support of its motion, Taylor RECC argued that disclosure of the information would permit an unfair commercial advantage to third parties and harm its ability to negotiate freely in the future with a potential seller.<sup>1</sup>

Having considered the motion and the material at issue, the Commission finds that the agreed upon purchase price contained in the purchase and sale agreement submitted as an exhibit to its application is generally recognized as confidential or proprietary; it therefore meets the criteria for confidential treatment and should be exempted from public disclosure pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878(1)(c)(1).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Taylor RECC's February 5, 2026 motion for confidential treatment is granted.

2. The designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order shall not be placed in the public record or made available for public inspection until the purchase and sale agreement is approved and the purchase and sale is complete or until further order of this Commission.

3. Use of the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order in any Commission proceeding shall comply with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(9).

4. If the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order becomes publicly available or no longer qualifies for confidential treatment, Taylor RECC shall inform the Commission and file with the Commission an unredacted copy of the designated material.

5. If a nonparty to this proceeding requests to inspect the material granted confidential treatment by this Order and the period during which the material has been granted confidential treatment has not expired, Taylor RECC shall have 20 days from receipt of written notice of the request to demonstrate that the material still falls within the exclusions from disclosure requirements established in KRS 61.878. If Taylor RECC is unable to make such demonstration, the requested material shall be made available for inspection. Otherwise, the Commission shall deny the request for inspection.

6. The Commission shall not make the requested material available for inspection for 30 days from the date of service of an Order finding that the material no

longer qualifies for confidential treatment in order to allow Taylor RECC to seek a remedy afforded by law.

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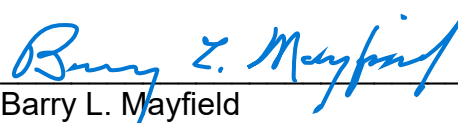
