



it refunded the automatic deduction in dispute and agreed to enter a new 12-month installment plan with Mr. Marnhout.<sup>4</sup> LG&E explained that Mr. Marnhout understands the terms of the new installment plan.<sup>5</sup> LG&E stated that Mr. Marnhout has indicated to LG&E that he is satisfied with the resolution and agrees that dismissal of the Complaint is appropriate.<sup>6</sup> Mr. Marnhout has not objected or otherwise responded to LG&E's May 6, 2026 motion to dismiss.

Based on the information in the record, the Commission finds that Michael Wayne Marnhout's complaint should be dismissed as satisfied, Staff's First Request should be remanded, and this case should be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Michael Wayne Marnhout complaint is dismissed as satisfied.
2. Staff's First Request to LG&E due on May 11, 2026, is remanded.
3. A copy of this Order shall be served by the Executive Director or their designee via U.S. Postal Service, First Class mail on Michael Wayne Marnhout at 4010 Woodstone Way, Louisville, KY 40241.
4. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
