COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO EAST KENTUCKY MIDSTREAM, L.L.C.

East Kentucky Midstream, LLC (East Kentucky Midstream), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on September 18, 2026. The Commission directs East Kentucky Midstream to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the

response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

East Kentucky Midstream shall make timely amendment to any prior response if East Kentucky Midstream obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which East Kentucky Midstream fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, East Kentucky Midstream shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, East Kentucky Midstream shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to East Kentucky Midstream's response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information (Staff's First Request), Item 6. Provide a list of all industry associations of which East Kentucky Midstream is a member.

2. Refer to East Kentucky Midstream's response to Staff's First Request, Item 4. Describe what East Kentucky Midstream defines as "service installation/reconnection" as used in the response.

3. Refer to East Kentucky Midstream's response to Staff's First Request, Item 8(a). Provide the length and terms of each indebtedness listed, including but not limited to interest rate. Provide an amortization schedule of each indebtedness listed.

4. Refer to East Kentucky Midstream's response to Staff's First Request, Item 22. Provide the monthly and annual usage for each special contract customer, for the three most recent calendar years.

5. Refer to East Kentucky Midstream's response to Staff's First Request, Item 24. Explain if East Kentucky Midstream has a policy regarding late fees. If so, provide the policy.

6. Refer to the filing made on August 10, 2026, specifically PDF page 5. Explain if natural gas service is guaranteed to the 17 commercial and industrial customers, by customer.

7. Refer to East Kentucky Midstream's response to Staff's First Request, Item 1a, Trial Balances. Provide an explanation of the revenues/expenses included in each of the categories below:

- a. Severance Tax Reimbursed;
- b. Misc Income;
- c. Producer Statement;
- d. Leased Employee Expenses;
- e. Amortization Expense;
- f. Outside Services;
- g. Professional Fees; and
- h. Taxes.

8. State the last time East Kentucky Midstream performed a Cost-of-Service Study (COSS). If a COSS was performed, provide the COSS.

9. State the last time East Kentucky Midstream implemented a rate increase. Provide an explanation for how the revenues required were determined and costs were allocated when that rate increase was calculated.

10. Confirm whether all rates and charges included in East Kentucky Midstream's current tariff on file with the Commission include the correct rates and charges being billed to East Kentucky Midstream customers. If not, then explain the customer classification and provide the rates and charges being billed to these customers.

11. State whether East Kentucky Midstream serves or expects to serve any "free gas" customers who receive gas in exchange for pipeline crossing their property. If so, provide the number and average annual usage for these customers and the lease or right-of-way agreement.

12. State whether East Kentucky Midstream purchases gas for redelivery to customers. If so, provide details of the transactions involved in procuring gas for the customers, including volumes and number of customers involved.

13. Describe the source of the gas delivered to East Kentucky Midstream's customers. If East Kentucky Midstream has an active contract with its suppliers, then provide those contracts.

14. Describe the quality of the gas supplied to East Kentucky Midstream's customers. The description should include, but not be limited to, whether dehydration

equipment is used, whether the gas is odorized, and whether compression equipment is used to deliver the gas.

15. State whether all of East Kentucky Midstream customers are served from gathering lines or from transmission lines carrying gas beyond their properties for sale to the wholesale market.

16. Provide the amount of disconnects and explain the reasons for the disconnects performed by East Kentucky Midstream in the past three calendar years.

17. Explain whether existing customer connections have been extended or divided to provide service to more than one customer. If so, include supporting documentation.

18. Explain whether East Kentucky Midstream employs anyone in its service territory to respond to emergencies. If not, explain how East Kentucky Midstream responds to emergencies.

19. Provide a system map or maps that show East Kentucky Midstream's natural gas system, including the location, size, category, and material of lines and the location of producing wells.

20. Provide 12 months of NYMEX gas futures prices that could be used for determining the average wholesale gas cost.

21. Provide the Btu factor of the gas East Kentucky Midstream delivers to its customers for both the most recent 12-month period and calendar year of 2025

22. Provide 12 months of the Appalachian differential, which is the difference between the NYMEX price at the Henry Hub and the Columbia Gas Transmission (TCO) Appalachian hub for both the most recent 12-month period and for calendar year of 2025.

23. State whether East Kentucky Midstream has any operator qualifications or operations and maintenance plans or performs leakage or patrolling surveys. If so, provide the details.

24. Provide any copies of any contracts for service for East Kentucky Midstream, not included in any response or filing to this point in this matter.
