line companies) ORDER NO. 4

The Commission, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the Public Service Commission Act, deeming it advisable to have all pipe line companies operating in the Commonwealth of Kentucky to keep a classification of accounts, and after due consideration thereof, adopts the classification of accounts prescribed by the Interstate Commerce Commission, which classification of accounts was adopted by the Interstate Commerce Commission by order of December 22, 1914, and is more specifically known as a "classification of investment in pipe lines, pipe line operating revenues, and pipe operating expenses of carriers by pipe lines."

All amendments to the above mentioned classification which may from time to time be issued by the Interstate Commerce Commission are to become a part of the classification without further order from this Commission.

The Commission also adopts the regulations governing the destruction of records of carriers by pipe line prescribed by the Interstate Commerce Commission and orders all carriers by pipe line under its jurisdiction to maintain records in accordance with such regulations.
