ORDER

Preface

The Commission by Interim Order entered May 21, 1980, authorized Webster County Water District, hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant," to construct the proposed water distribution system and approved the method of financing. Therefore, this Order addresses the Applicant's proposed water service rates.

FINDINGS IN THIS MATTER

The Commission, after consideration of all the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds:

1. That the Applicant's annual operating expenses including those of depreciation, interest and taxes are estimated to be approximately \$114,910 for the first year of operations after completion of construction.

2. That the rates and charges proposed by the Applicant and prescribed and set forth in Appendix "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, should produce revenues of approximately \$121,971 for the first year of operations after completion of construction.

3. That utilization of the \$40,000 reserve fund, as set forth in FmHA letter of conditions dated August 8, 1979, to be used as needed over the first five (5) years of operation, should produce a net income of \$15,061 during the first year of operation. Further, that these rates and charges approved herein are fair, just and reasonable rates for customers to be served by the proposed construction, in that they will, in conjunction with these reserve funds, provide sufficient revenues to service the debt, provide for operating expenses, and the accumulation of a reasonable surplus.

4. That the Applicant should refund all deposits collected from prospective water customers, who will not receive water service upon completion of current construction project.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the rates and charges proposed by the Applicant as prescribed and set forth in Appendix "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof be and are hereby fixed and prescribed as the fair, just and reasonable rates and charges for water services rendered by the Webster County Water District on and after the date of this Order.

2. That Webster County Water District shall file its tariff sheets setting forth the rates and charges approved herein and all rules and regulations of the utility within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

3. That within thirty (30) days of substantial completion of the current construction project, the Applicant shall file with this Commission a list of prospective water customers who will not receive the water service and a plan whereby said customers' deposits shall be refunded.

4. That the Applicant shall file with this Commission a certificate of compliance, stating that all refunds have been made, within thirty (30) days of the completion of said refunds.
