ORDER

On April 11, 1930, Kentucky Power Company was ordered to appear before the Energy Regulatory Commission for the purpose of an examination of the Company's application of its fuel adjustment clause for the period November 1, 1979 to April 30, 1980. On May 21, 1980, a public hearing was held at the offices of the Commission in Frankfort, Kentucky. The Consumer Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General was the only intervenor to participate in the public hearing.

The Energy Regulatory Commission of Kentucky is of the opinion from the evidence introduced at the hearing that Kentucky Power Company has complied with the provisions of 807 KAR 50:075, Uniform Fuel Adjustment Clause.
