IT IS ORDERED, that the Washington Lewisburg Water District shall file an original and twelve (12) copies of the following information with the Commission (with a copy to the Attorney General's Consumer Intervention Division) by December 9, 1980:

- (1) Supply copies of monthly water bills from the Maysville Utility Commission for the test period which will agree with "per books" purchased water cost of \$36,232.07.
- (2) Supply a copy of the computation on adjusted water purchases of \$51,087.22.
- (3) With reference to Exhibit "C" supply the monthly dollar amounts pertaining to water purchased and sold.
- (4) Supply a detailed analysis of the following accounts appearing on the Comparative Income Statement with copies of invoices for all amounts over \$50.00:

(a)	Operation Supplies & Expenses	\$ 4,888.52
(b)	Transmission & Dist. Expenses	19,959.63
(c)	Office Supplies & Other Expenses	1,411.24
(d)	Miscellaneous General Expenses	1,952.12

- (5) The Commission will need more detailed information as to the Projected Capital addition of \$14,000 and the related pro forma adjustment to depreciation expense in the amount of \$280.00
  - (a) When is it to be constructed?
  - (b) Source of Construction funds?
  - (c) For what purpose is the costs?
  - (d) When is proposed construction to go into service?

- (6) Account for the abnormally high Line Loss of 18.44%.
- (7) Amortization schedule on debt to substantiate interest cost of \$18,476.25.
