O R D E R

On August 4, 1980 the Commission received a copy of a letter dated April 3, 1980 from Jerry F. Taylor, County Judge/Executive, Whitley County, Kentucky stating that the Whitley County Fiscal Court is in the process of completing the construction of a water line in southern Whitley County adjacent to the City of Jellico, Tennessee. According to the letter the waterline is estimated to serve less than 50 customers, and it would not be feasible for the existing Whitley County Water District to provide service. The letter requests that the City of Jellico be permitted to serve the area pursuant to the appropriate regulatory authority of the State of Tennessee rather than the Commission.

The Commission, having considered the matter and being advised hereby ORDERS That this matter be and it hereby is set for hearing on September 10, 1980 at 1:30 p.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky for the purpose of receiving testimony with respect to the feasibility of providing water service to the area in question.
