O R D E R

On November 11, 1981, South Central Bell Telephone Company made a tariff filing with the Commission, wherein it proposed to obsolete and eventually discontinue series 5000 Channel Service, commonly referred to as Telpak. Telpak obsolescence has previously been considered by the Commission in Case No. 7314, South Central Bell, and is presently under consideration in Case No. 8308, Cincinnati Bell.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff filing. However, investigation and hearing cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed tariff filing be and it is hereby suspended from the proposed effective date of November 29, 1981, for a period of five months. The page of the proposed tariff filing hereby suspended is:
