ORDER

On March 11, 1982 the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Finance and Administration Cabinet ("Finance") filed its motion seeking an order compelling South Central Bell ("South Central") to produce certain cost studies and source documents. Finance also sought additional time in which to request a further hearing after receipt of the documents requested. On March 18, 1982, South Central filed its response to Finance's motion stating that it had no objection to an enlargement of time for Finance to request a further hearing nor to providing the requested cost studies to counsel for Finance and any employee or designated expert provided that all persons inspecting the studies execute an agreement regarding disclosure. The source documents requested by Finance have either already been provided or will be provided by April 1, 1982 as separately ordered in a Commission data request.



The Commission having considered the motion and response and being sufficiently advised finds that the outstanding portions of Finance's motion should be sustained.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the motion of Finance seeking access to certain cost studies of South Central is sustained provided that counsel for Finance, and any other employee or expert on its behalf, execute an agreement with South Central regarding disclosure of the information prior to receipt of the studies.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Finance be and hereby is granted an enlargement of time until April 15, 1982 in which to request a further hearing.
