O R D E R

On November 10, 1982, Continental Telephone Company of Kentucky ("Continental"), by counsel, filed its Motion to Deviate from Publication Rule (807 KAR 5:011, Section 8 (2c) which requires the filing notice to be published once a week for three consecutive weeks, the first notice to appear prior to the filing of an application for an adjustment of rates.

The Motion states that the first notice appeared October 28, 1982, but Continental failed to reinsert the notice the next two weeks and did not realize its dereliction until it received the Commission's Order of Procedure entered November 3, 1982. The Motion further states that Continental could reinsert the notices on Thursday, November 18, 1982, and Wednesday, November 24, 1982, if authorized, and would be in substantial compliance with the above regulation.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that publication of the notice on November 18, 1982, and November 24, 1982, is in substantial compliance with 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8 (2c), and a deviation should be granted pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, Section 13.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the Motion of Continental  
be and it hereby is sustained.
