O R D E R

On October 21, 1983, Kentucky Cable Television Association, Inc. ("KCTA"), by counsel, filed its Petition for Rehearing and Request for Suspension of Tariff. The Motion states, among other things, that the rates and many of the terms and conditions in the tariff of South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") are unfair and unreasonable. The Motion discusses the components of the rate and specific terms and conditions which are included in the tariff.

On October 27, 1983, South Central Bell, by counsel, filed its Response to the Petition stating, among other things, that South Central Bell's tariff became effective on the date stated in the tariff, October 13, 1983, and further, that the Commission entered its final Order concerning CATV pole attachment rate methodology in Administrative Case No. 251 (In the Matter of the Adoption of a Standard Methodology for Establishing Rates for Cable Television Pole Attachments), not in this proceeding.




The Commission, having considered the Petition for Rehearing, the Response, and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that the tariff of South Central Bell, pursuant to the Commission's Order entered June 1, 1983, became effective

October 13, 1983, and the Commission's Order entered September 17, 1982, concerning CATV pole attachment rate methodology is now the subject of an action before the Franklin Circuit Court in which KCTA is a party. The basis of KCTA's Petition for Rehearing is its disagreement with the methodology adopted by the Commission for handling these tariffs. Accordingly, the Petition for Rehearing and Request for Suspension of Tariff of KCTA should be denied. However, KCTA may pursue its objections by complaint pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.260 and 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 11 and 12.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition for Rehearing be and it hereby is denied.
