ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Yorktown Sewage Treatment Facilities, Inc., ("Yorktown") shall file an original and seven copies of the following information with the Commission with a copy to all parties of record by August 15, 1983. If neither the requested information nor a motion for an extension of time is filed by the stated date, the case may be dismissed.

The Commission, in its Order of July 13, 1983, requested that Yorktown furnish full and reasonable justification supporting the necessity for the legal services of \$3,857 rendered by the firm, Amshoff and Amshoff, in the preparation of its rate application. On July 22, 1983, the Commission received a reply from Amshoff and Amshoff in behalf of its client, Yorktown. In the second paragraph of the response, its states that the hourly rate was \$75 per hour rather than \$95 per hour. Moreover, the reply stated that a total of 50 hours had been devoted to the gathering, tabulating and copying the information requested by the Public Service Commission.

The Commission is of the opinion that more detailed analysis of the 50 hours spent by the attorneys should be provided in order to permit the Commission to consider the legal expenses associated with this case which appear out of line with expenses in similar cases.
