ORDER


On June 17, 1983, the Commission entered its Order directing Thacker-Grigsby Telephone Company, Inc. ("Thacker-Grigsby") to file certain information with the Commission by June 30, 1983.

On June 29, 1983, Thacker-Grigsby filed a Motion requesting a thirty-day extension. By Order entered July 5, 1983, the Commission granted the extension; however, the information was not submitted.

By letters to Thacker-Grigsby dated August 3, 1983, and August 16, 1983, the Commission requested that the information be provided. Neither the requested information nor a response has been received from Thacker-Grigsby.

The Commission, having considered the matter and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that this case should be dismissed for failure to submit the requested information.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
