ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Tri-Village Water District ("Tri-Village") shall file an original and seven copies of the following information with the Commission with a copy to all parties of record by July 18, 1983. If neither the requested information nor a motion for an extension of time is filed by the stated date, the case may be dismissed.

- 1. Provide a copy of the working papers related to an increase in purchased water expense of \$8,743. Also, provide a detailed explanation of the audit adjustment dated December 31, 1982, of \$6,037.50.
- 2. Provide a more detailed explanation of the maintenance charges appearing on the following statements, invoices and cancelled check:
- a. Statement of the Mid-States Meter and Supply Company, Inc. dated April 30, 1982, totaling \$5,328.28.
- b. Statement of the Mid-States Meter and Supply Company, Inc. dated September 30, 1982, totaling \$967.00.

- c. Check number 6721 dated May 21, 1982, payable to Ross Valve Mfg. Co., Inc., in the amount of \$584.90. The Commission is of the opinion that this item of expense should be capital item. Please submit your opinion.
- 3. Provide the date and amount of each increase in 1983 to employee wages.
- 4. Provide a detailed explanation of the charges of \$1,557 in the account Injuries and Damages, which increased \$1,349 over the amount in 1981.
- 5. Provide a copy of the invoices related to Outside Services Employed of \$1,254.
- 6. Provide a detailed analysis of any rate case expense related to the preparation of this case and the account charged with such expense.
- 7. The 1981 annual report shows 859 metered residential customers and the 1982 annual report shows 785 or a loss of 74 customers. Please explain this loss in customers.
- 8. Provide the following information with regard to Notes Payable of \$35,000 and pro forma interest expense of \$4,500:
- a. A detailed list of each note and the applicable interest rate.
- b. The reason each note was issued (use of the proceeds).
