## ORDER

1

On April 30, 1984, Radio Communications Corporation ("RCC") and Tri State Electronics, Inc., ("Tri State") filed a joint application requesting Commission approval of the transfer of RCC's Harlan Division assets to Tri State.

Based on the evidence of record, and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and hereby finds that:

1. On February 16, 1984, RCC and Tri State entered into a sales contract setting forth the rights and obligations of the respective parties regarding the sale and transfer to Tri State of RCC's Harlan Division assets and liabilities.

2. RCC desires to transfer its Harlan Division assets and liabilities to Tri State and Tri State desires to purchase and assume them.

3. Tri State possesses the requisite expertise to own, operate and manage a radio communication utility and provide adequate, efficient and reasonable service to its customers. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the transfer of assets of RCC's Harlan Division to Tri State be and it hereby is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Tri State shall issue a notice adopting the rates, classifications and regulations of RCC and within 10 days thereafter shall issue and file tariffs in its own name pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10.
