On June 20, 1984, South Central Bell filed a proposed tariff which would establish ESSX-1/Multiline Service Option. The tariff proposes new rates for an existing service based primarily on quantity of lines purchased.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff.
