On July 20, 1984, AT&T Communications filed a tariff proposal offering two optional calling plans, Reach Out Kentucky and AT&T Pro Kentucky. No adequate cost of service study has been filed, per Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:011, to justify the proposed rates. Failure to provide the required documentation has seriously shortened the timespan necessary for full Commission review of the proposed tariff and its determination as to the positive or negative impact of the tariff upon the overall telephone rates of the citizens of Kentucky.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed tariff be and it hereby is suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date of August 20, 1984. The pages of the tariff hereby suspended are:
