O R D E R

South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("South Kentucky") by letter received October 11, 1984, and amended by letter received October 25, 1984, requested permission to deviate from Regulation 807 KAR 5:006, Section 15. The deviation request was made in compliance with Regulation 807 KAR Section 24, and consisted of requesting permission to transfer its electric meter test records and historical data from a manual card file system to an in-house computer data storage and retrieval system.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

1. All meter test records and historical data required by regulation 807 KAR 5:006, Section 15, will be maintained in the computer storage system;

2. Adequate provisions for protection of stored data and retrieval from the computer system have been made; and


3. The proposed system will improve the meter record keeping operation of South Kentucky and will benefit both South

Kentucky and its members; therefore, this application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of South Kentucky for a deviation from the requirements of regulation 807 KAR 5:006, Section 15, be and it hereby is approved, and the meter test and historical data may be transferred from the manual card file system to an electronic computer information storage and retrieval system.
