O R D E R

On February 14, 1985, Cincinnati SMSA Limited Partnership filed a tariff with the Commission proposing rate changes in its tariff to reflect the elimination of usage charges for mobile originated calls that are not completed, lowering of the minimum rates for Basic Service, expansion of the discount schedule and changes in resale regulations.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff. However, investigation and hearing cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed tariff be and it hereby is suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date of March 2, 1985. The pages of the tariff hereby suspended are:
