On July 18, 1986, AT&T South, Inc., ("AT&T South") filed a Motion requesting a conference with Commission staff to discuss and clarify the Commission position with respect to detariffing specialized customer premises equipment for the disabled. On August 6, 1986, the Commission held an informal conference in Administrative Case No. 269, the Sale and Detariffing of Embedded Customer Premises Equipment, during which this issue was discussed. Further public hearings have been scheduled to begin in Administrative Case No. 269 beginning on November 29, 1986. We are of the opinion that another informal conference at this time is unnecessary prior to the public hearings.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That AT&T South's Motion for an informal conference be and it hereby is denied.
