On December 20, 1985, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9290 wherein it approved Lake Village Water Association, Inc.'s, ("Lake Village") proposal to be included in the Water Loss Demonstration Project ("Demonstration"). In approving Lake Village's inclusion in the Demonstration the Commission requested that within 30 days from the date of the Final Order that Lake Village should file the following information:

Lake Village shall identify the sources of the excessive unaccounted-for water, estimate or prioritize the amount of water loss from each source, and submit to the Commission a detailed plan to reduce its excessive unaccounted-for water to include a time schedule and target.

The aforementioned requested information has yet to be filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Lake Village shall file either the information requested in the Order dated December 20, 1985, or a request for an extension of time within 2 weeks of the date of this Order.
