IT IS ORDERED that the Alumax Aluminum Corporation ("ALUMAX"), shall file an original and 12 copies of the following information with this Commission, with a copy to all parties of record. Where a narrative discussion or explanation is requested, explain in detail all components used in each calculation including the methodology employed and all assumptions applied in the derivation of each calculation. Failure to provide clear, concise workpapers and other calculations where requested may necessitate further information requests. Careful attention should be given to copied material to insure that it is legible. The information requested herein is due no later than December 1, 1986. If the information cannot be provided by this date, you should submit a motion for an extension of time stating the reason a delay is necessary and include a date by which it will be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission.

The following question is directed to Clyde M. Griggs:


1. Does the present contract between ALUMAX and Big Rivers prevent Big Rivers from implementing or changing a ratchet provision? Explain why or why not.
