SHOW CAUSE ORDER

The Commission, on the party's Motion, HEREBY ORDERS that the hearing scheduled on August 27, 1986, at 2:30 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time, be and it hereby is rescheduled on October 14, 1986, at 1:30 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time.

In a letter filed September 5, 1986, Davis Branch Gas Company set forth reasons for the inability to attend the hearing. The Commission will treat this letter as a Motion.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, FINDS that the Motion should be sustained.

The purpose of the hearing is to consider testimony and other evidence of Davis Branch Gas Company as to why it should not be penalized for failure to comply with the Commission's regulations, correction of its cited violations and resolution of the delinquent bill with its gas supplier.
