O R D E R

On July 22, 1988, National-Southwire Aluminum Company ("NSA") filed a Motion for Full Intervention in this proceeding. Pursuant to KRS 278.300(2), this proceeding must be disposed of within 60 days from the date of the filing of June 30, 1988. The Commission's normal practice in financing and construction cases is to issue a decision based on the record without holding a public hearing. If NSA believes that a public hearing is necessary, it should request one within 7 days of the date of this Order.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, hereby Orders that the Motion be and it hereby is granted and NSA shall have 7 days from the date of this Order to request a public hearing.
