O R D E R

On September 23, 1988, the applicant in the above-styled proceeding filed a petition pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, requesting confidential treatment for certain documents relating to the request of Com/Nav Marine, Inc. ("Com/Nav"), for authority to provide marine two-way radio service from a public coast station within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Exhibits for which confidential treatment is sought include those showing the cost of operating the Paducah public coast station for the year ending December 31, 1987 (Confidential Exhibit 1), the average number of calls handled by Com/Nav's Paducah public coast station and the actual number of calls handled by the Paducah facility during May and June, 1988 (Confidential Exhibit 2).

The Commission, having reviewed the petition for confidential treatment, finds that the petition is consistent with the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the petition for confidential treatment be and it hereby is granted.
