
AT&T filed a petition for confidential treatment of its responses to the Attorney General's supplemental requests for information. The information was filed with the Commission and furnished to the Attorney General. The information consists of revenue data for specific services and is competitively significant. For the reasons stated in the petition, the Commission, being advised, hereby grants the petition pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.

MCI Telecommunications Corporation filed a letter, which the Commission will treat as a petition for confidential treatment of its responses to the Commission's data request of September 30, 1987. The Company asserts that it considers the information confidential and proprietary and that its disclosure would be competitively damaging. The Commission, being advised, hereby grants the petition pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.
