ORDER

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, Section 1(11), the Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued an Order on June 1, 1987, requiring Shelby Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Shelby") to notify its customers of a hearing to be held on July 23, 1987. Shelby was not required to appear at the scheduled hearing unless an appearance was requested by the Attorney General's Utility and Rate Intervention Division or other interested parties, or by the Commission on its own motion. Furthermore, Shelby filed an affidavit stating its compliance with the provisions of the Fuel Adjustment Clause as prescribed in 807 KAR 5:056. Shelby also filed its monthly fuel charges for the 6-month period under review.

Following proper notice, no party of record requested Shelby to appear at the hearing scheduled for July 23, 1987. After reviewing Shelby's monthly fuel clause filings for the 6-month period under review, the Commission is of the opinion that Shelby has complied with the provisions of 807 KAR 5:056. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the charges and credits billed by Shelby through the Fuel Adjustment Clause for the period November 1, 1986, through April 30, 1987, be and they hereby are approved.
