ORDER

Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District ("Jessamine-South Elkhorn District") has petitioned for rehearing on the Commission's Orders of April 30, 2013. The intervening parties have responded to this petition. Jessamine-South Elkhorn District has submitted a reply to this response.

Finding that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District has raised numerous issues that require further study and that the merits of its petition cannot be addressed satisfactorily without further study, the Commission finds that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's petition should be granted for the limited purpose of further considering the questions raised in the petition. The Commission expects to issue a decision on these questions within 30 days.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's petition for rehearing is granted for the purpose of allowing the Commission additional time to address the merits of its petition.
