ORDER

Nolin Rural Electric Corporation (“Nolin”) filed an application on April 15, 2013,¹ seeking Commission approval to enter into a loan agreement with the National Rural Utilities Cooperative Finance Corporation (“CFC”). Pursuant to KRS 278.300, the Commission is required to adjudicate financing applications within 60 days of filing, unless good cause exists to continue the application beyond the 60-day statutory period.


On June 3, 2013, Nolin filed a request to have an informal conference scheduled for June 24, 2013, at which representatives from Fort Knox would provide an overview of the proposed construction of generation units at the military base and the relationship of that construction to the CFC loan.

¹ Nolin initially filed its financing application on March 27, 2013. However, due to certain filing deficiencies, Nolin’s application is considered to have been filed on April 15, 2013 the date upon which it cured those filing deficiencies.


In light of the timing of Nolin's request for an informal conference, the Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.300(2), good cause exists to continue our review of the instant application for a longer time than the 60-day statutory period.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Nolin's request for approval of its financing is continued beyond the 60-day time limit set forth in KRS 278.300(2).
