classes A and B telephone companies) ORDER NO. 7A

The Commission pursuant to the authority vested in it by Sub-section (j) of Section 4 of the Public Service Commission Act, deeming it advisable to have classes A and B telephone companies as hereinafter described operating in this Commonwealth and under the jurisdiction of this Commission file the following annual report forms, and it is so


ORDERED, That the annual report form M, prescribed by the Federal Communications Commission for classes A and B telephone companies be and the same is hereby adopted and it is further specified that class A companies are those which have an average annual operating revenue exceeding one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) dollars and class B companies are those which have an average annual operating revenue exceeding fifty thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars, but not more than one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) dollars, and it is further

ORDERED, And the Secretary is directed to mail on or before Monday, February 11, 1935, to all of such telephone companies, classes A and B, two copies of the said annual report form with directions to fill out same in accordance with the instructions contained therein, and that one copy of such report be returned to this Commission on or before May 1, 1935, and the other copy of such report be retained in the files of the utility, and it is further

ORDERED, That the words "Federal Communications Commission" when used in the said annual report form shall be construed to mean the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, and it is further

ORDERED, That each utility be furnished a self-addressed card to the Commission, on which it shall be required to acknowledge receipt of such annual report form not later than March 4, 1935, and it is further

ORDERED, That any utility who is in doubt as to the meaning of any account, definition or instruction provided in this form communicate with the Commission on or before March 4, 1935, and request an explanation or interpretation of same.
