ADMINISTRATIVE CASE NO. 44.

O R D E R

It is ordered by the Commission that Paragraph 1, Rule VII, "Applications for Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity", (Page 42 Rules of Procedure July 15, 1934) be and it hereby is amended so as to read as follows:

1. New Construction or Extension. When application is made by any public utility, person, firm, or corporation for a certificate that the present or future public convenience or necessity requires, or will require, the construction of an extension of facilities, the applicant, in addition to complying with Rule V, shall submit the following data, either in the application or as exhibits made a part thereto:

(a) Copy of Articles of Incorporation as provided by Sub-section 5 of Rule V.

(b) The facts showing that the proposed new construction is or will be required by public convenience or necessity.

(c) Copies of franchise or permits, if any, from the proper public authority for the proposed new construction or extension.

(d) A full description of the proposed location, route, or routes of the new construction or extension, including a description of the manner in which same will be constructed, and also the names of all public utilities, corporations, or persons with whom the proposed new construction or extension is likely to compete.

(e) Three maps to suitable scale (preferably not more than two miles per inch) shall be supplied, showing the location or route of the proposed new construction or extension, as well as the location to scale of any like facilities owned by others located anywhere within the map area submitted, with adequate identification as to the ownership of such other facilities.


(f) Applicant shall furnish all such data as is necessary to a complete understanding of the situation.


(g) The manner in detail in which it is proposed to finance the new construction or extension.


(h) An estimated cost of operation after the proposed plant is completed.
