O R D E R

By letter dated the 19th day of January, 1963, directed to the Commission by O. L. Kerth, International Representative of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, a request was made for an opportunity to be heard relative to the Commission adopting proposed safety regulations.


On the 25th day of April, 1963, the Commission, on its own motion, ordered that a hearing be held on the necessity of adopting additional safety rules. Said hearing was scheduled for the 14th day of May, 1963. Subsequently, an Order was entered canceling the hearing of May 14, 1963, and rescheduling the hearing for the 8th day of July, 1963. At the opening of the scheduled hearing, it was developed that the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers was without counsel as required by law and the case was continued generally in order to give them an opportunity to procure legal counsel.

An examination of the record reveals that as of this date the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers has not obtained counsel in this matter nor has it advised the Commission in any manner since the hearing of July 8, 1963.




