REVISION OF PSC: GEN-1-VI) ADMINISTRATIVE CASE NO. 134

O R D E R

On January 22, 1971 a conference was held in the Commission's offices to consider a proposed change in Commission's Rule PSC: Gen-1-VI, Meter Readings and Information.

On July 21, 1971 a hearing was held at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky to consider adoption of changes in PSC: Gen-1-VI. All parties of interest were notified and given an opportunity to be heard at the time and place of hearing.

The Commission after consideration of the proposed rule, the testimony and exhibits of record and being advised is of the opinion and finds that Paragraph 1. of PSC: Gen-1-VI should be changed to read as set out herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That PSC: Gen-1-VI-1 shall be modified to read as follows:

1. Information on Bills

Each bill rendered periodically by water, gas and electric utilities shall show the class of service, the present and last preceding meter readings, the date of the present reading, the number of units consumed, the meter constant, if any, the net amount for service rendered, all taxes, the adjustments, if any, and the gross amount of the bill. The date after which a penalty may apply to the gross amount must be indicated. Estimated or calculated bills shall be distinctly marked as such.

The rate schedule under which the bill is computed shall be furnished under one of the following methods:


1. By printing rate schedule on the bill.
2. By publishing in a newspaper of general circulation once each year or when rate is changed.
3. By mailing to each customer once each year or when rate is changed.
4. By providing a place on each bill where a customer may indicate his desire for a copy of the applicable rates and furnishing same by return first class mail.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That PSC: Gen-1-VI - 2, 3 and 4 shall remain the same as previously approved by the Commission.
