ORDER

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of Kentucky by virtue of House Bill 313, duly enacted and signed by the Governor, has provided that the Secretary of the Commission and the Commission Staff Directors shall, as determined by the Commission, assist the Commissioners in carrying out policy-making functions under K.R.S. Chapter 278; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Commission and the Commission Staff Directors have historically been, are now and will in the future assist the Commission in policy-making functions under K.R.S., Chapter 278;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that the positions of Secretary of the Commission, Director of Accounting and Director of Engineering be, and they are hereby, declared to be policy-making positions; and those persons who now fill, or in the future will fill, those positions shall assist the Commission in carrying out its policy-making functions under Chapter 278 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and this determination shall not be subject to the provisions of Section 18.150

of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.
